Despite a difficult economic period, The Francis Ouimet Scholarship Fund has pledged to hold the line on scholarships, with no student having their scholarship reduced from the previous year. 2009-2010 awards will total \$1.325 Million to 354 scholars from 129 clubs across the state. Thank you for your support!

The scholars that you support give at least two years of service to golf as caddies, or in pro shop or course superintendent operations in Massachusetts. Since our founding in 1949, we have awarded more than \$20.5 Million in need based scholarships to over 4,600 young students, with \$10 Million being awarded over this past decade!

Please help us to promote the scholarship and encourage applicants. Young people at your club should know that applications will be available in mid-summer and are due December 1st.
