## 2010-2011 SCHOLARSHIP INCREASE

After a year in which the Ouimet Fund was able to "Hold the Line" on scholarship amounts awarded, we are pleased to announce another milestone in our effort to award as much aid to scholars as possible. For this school year, we are pleased to announce a 10% increase in scholarship dollars awarded, bringing the 2010-2011 total to \$1.46 Million! Thank you for your support!

Our scholars give at least two years of service to golf as caddies, or in pro shop or course superintendent operations in Massachusetts. Since our founding in 1949, we have awarded more than \$22 Million in need based scholarships to over 4,700 young students, with \$10.5 Million being awarded over this past decade!

Please help us to promote the scholarship and encourage applicants. Young people at your club should know that applications will be available in mid-summer and are due December 1st.
